

POV is the longest-running independent documentary showcase on American television. Since 1988, POV has presented films on PBS that capture the full spectrum of the human experience, with a long commitment to centering women and people of color in front of, and behind, the camera.

The series is known for introducing generations of viewers to groundbreaking works like *Tongues Untied, American Promise, Minding The Gap* and *Not Going Quietly*, and innovative filmmakers including Jonathan Demme, Laura Poitras and Nanfu Wang. POV goes "beyond the broadcast" to bring powerful nonfiction storytelling to viewers wherever they are.
















POV Shorts launched in 2018 as one of the first PBS series dedicated to bold and timely short-form documentaries.

The series is known for its curation, and for broadcasting award-winning titles, including: Emmy® nominated *Earthrise, Water Warriors, The Changing Same*, Emmy® winner *The Love Bugs* and the Oscar® shortlisted *A Broken House* and *Águilas*. It won Best Short Form Series at the IDA Documentary Awards in 2020 and 2022.

POV Shorts' sixth season continues the tradition of presenting a broad array of the best in short form documentary from both seasoned and emerging filmmakers, covering a variety of topics and creative approaches. This season's slate of films presents personal stories, tackles social issues, and breaks artistic boundaries.

A co-production of <u>WORLD</u> and American Documentary, America ReFramed, curates a diverse selection of independent documentaries that brings to national audiences compelling stories which illuminate the changing contours of our ever-evolving country to national audiences. Viewers are immersed in stories that span the spectrum of American life, from the streets of towns big and small to its exurbs and country roads. Each season, the series presents an array of personal voices and experiences through which we learn from our past, understand our present, and are challenged to seek new frameworks for America's future.

America ReFramed received a Peabody Award for <u>Deej</u> and an Alfred I. duPont-Columbia University Award for <u>Class of '27</u>. The series has earned several Christopher, GRACIE, Telly and Cine Golden Eagle Awards, as well as multiple nominations for Emmy, Independent Documentary Association and Imagen Awards.

P V Engage

For over 20 years, POV has pioneered models for civic engagement using independent documentary films by some of the most acclaimed storytellers of our time. The POV Engage team partners with community-based organizations, educators, librarians and other engaged community members to spark conversation about the issues presented in our films and digital productions. Free screenings, panel discussions and public events are designed to trigger action, from dialogue and feedback, to educational opportunities and community participation.

The <u>POV Community Network</u> makes more than 200 POV feature films, shorts and digital initiatives available for free to over 14,000 local and national partners. Join the Network to discover films by title or topic, plus accompanying materials such as discussion guides, promotional tools and other resources to help shape the conversation and inspire action.

POV collaborates with media educators to produce lesson plans for teachers interested in using our films as a teaching tool. We offer free resources for educators, including 200+ online film clips connected to 100+ standards-aligned lesson plans, discussion guides and reading lists.
